Quick Pointers

Important Times

- Entry to event site (Hwy K and Langberry Road) closes: 8:45AM
- Race Start: 9:00AM
- Course Closes: 10:30AM
- Live Music Starts (Stone Barone and the MadTones): 9:30AM
- Awards: Approximately 10:30AM

Day of Details:

- There is only one way in and out of Botham Vineyards, please plan accordingly!
- Parking is field parking.
- Bring blankets and chairs to sit on after the race to enjoy Stone Barone & the MadTones.
- Botham Vineyards' Tasting Room and Gift Shop will be open.
- Bar is cash only - you will get one free glass of wine or beer. Refills are \$5.
- You do NOT need to bring your Uncorked 5K wine glass, plastic cups will be provided and are preferred.

We urge you to pick up your packet early. If you choose to pick up race morning, please plan to arrive in plenty of time. The road leading to the venue is part of the race route. If you arrive too late, you will be held up from reaching the venue until after the start of the race. **You MUST be in the parking lot by no later than 8:45AM.**

Weather

The race will happen rain or shine.

- ➔ If there is rain in the forecast, please be prepared. Should things scale up to dangerous weather, the start will be delayed as we watch the radar. This event relies on county roads and permits, we are unable to delay later than 9:45AM.
- ➔ Please pay attention to possible weather updates from the race announcer.

Parking

- Patience is key! This is a field parking event.
- As you turn right and arrive at Botham Vineyards ([map](#)), you will pass the main entrance on Langberry Rd and continue to the parking entrance. After you enter the parking area PLEASE pay attention to the directions of the parking attendants in the orange vests waving flags. The attendants will help make sure everyone gets parked in a timely fashion. After the event, the lower exit to the parking lot will be opened up for use. Please exercise caution in the parking lot.

Restrooms

- There are plenty of restrooms available! The restrooms will be located by the barn (past the start line) as you approach the venue.

Course Directions/Map

Uncorked 5K near the Driftless Area of Wisconsin. *There are a few hills.*

- The course will leave Botham Vineyards and turn right UP Langberry Road
- Turn around counter clockwise at Lee Drive and head down to County Highway K
- Turn left and PLEASE stay INSIDE the centerline cones. Runners will run in the right running lane on the way out.
- Turnaround counter clockwise at S Jones Street (aid station). Proceed back down County Highway K in the right running lane again
- Turn right on Langberry and head UP to the Botham Vineyards entrance
- Turn right to the finish at Botham Vineyards! It's wine time!

Course Safety

- We have designed a safe, fun and challenging course for you. We urge you to exercise caution and pay attention to directions from course marshals and volunteers - they are out there for your safety!
- Stay within the cones on County Highway K and pay attention to your fellow runners. If you or someone else needs help, please report it to the nearest event rep.
- There is a water stop at approximately mile 1.86.

Race Bibs & Timing

- The Uncorked 5K is professionally timed by Race Day Events.
- Your race bib has your timing chip attached to the back side of it. Be sure to wear it on the front of you (more on that later) and on the top layer of clothing you wear. It is also very important you wear your bib during the event for safety reasons.
- **Remember: No Race Bib = No Chip = No Time! AND = No Drink Ticket = NO WINE!**

Results & Awards

- Race results will be posted near the party area as finishers come in.
- Running fast not only gets you to the wine sooner but might gain you a fancy award. We have awards for the top 3 women and men overall and in the follow age groups: 19 and under, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69 and 70+

Post-Race Party

- After you cross the finish line, it's on to the wine (and beer). Head over and grab your glass before you find a space to enjoy the funky live music by Stone Barone & the MadTones.
- Your first drink is on us, all you need is the pull tab from your race bib. After that, additional drinks are \$5. Botham has your glassware covered, too - no need to bring your new Uncorked glass with you. Save that to celebrate with later!
- What goes better with wine than food? Not much. Which is why we have invited a few food trucks for you to visit.
- We also suggest bringing a chair or blanket to spread out on the lawn to enjoy the day. Feel free to set it out prior to Race Start to avoid the trek back to your car post-race.
- With the music in the background and your friends by your side, don't forget to grab some photos. Use #uncorked5k and tag @uncorked5k when you share!
